



For those in the Salt Lake Valley we will meet at **10:00 a.m.** at the University Park Hotel parking lot (west side) located at 480 Wakara Way up by the University of Utah. Wakara Way is located east of Foothill Drive. We will drive up Emigration Canyon and then follow East Canyon up to Morgan and go to the **Riverside Park in Morgan City**, located at 195 E.125 North. As of the publishing of this newsletter, we have 40 Stateroom Cabins reserved for our July 2017 Viking River Cruise. The response has been overwhelming. All the French Balcony C and D cabins have been reserved. About half the cabins are with Utah Miata Club members and the other half are from members of 12 other Miata clubs in 12 different states. Some are family and friends of members that are not affiliated with a Miata club and don't want to miss this "trip of a lifetime." We welcome everyone who wants to come. This 15 day European River Tour will be the second week of July 2017, so we are 2 years and 1 month away from our departure time. Brent Jenson of Morris Murdock Travel is working on getting us some specific dates for the trip.

This cruise is specially priced at 2 FOR 1 Rates. It is a 2017 cruise for 2015 Pricing. The Deposit of \$500 per person is half the normal deposit required. If you are interested contact us and we will give you a **FREE DVD** of the cruise and email you links so you can view the ship, cabins, and itinerary. We have a **Reservation Form** that you can fill out with all the information that the travel agency needs to book your cabin. We will also email you a **Deck Plan** which lists all the rooms which are color coded and have pricing for each room. **Hurry and get your Rooms booked NOW**, as they are going fast and **almost half** of the Longship is already booked.

We are working with Morris Murdock Travel in Salt Lake and you can speak to our Cruise Agent, Amber Lee Johanson to book the cruise. Her phone number is 801-483-6314. Or you can email her at ajohanson@mnorrismurdock.com. The deposit is only \$500.00 per person (double occupancy/ 2 people per room). Note: Cabin Stateroom prices listed are per person. Deposit is fully refundable (see details on this). Just pay your deposit and set some money aside each month towards payment of the cruise. We recommend Travel Insurance which will be available in several months from now (around October 2015) to protect your investment in case something comes up.

The word is out now to other Miata people across the country in many other Miata Clubs to join us and is also on the Miata.Net Forum for the Southwest Region. You can get all the information and Registration form, Deck Plan and Itinerary on the Net, so sign up while the best rooms are still available. Information on Flights and cost of that part will be available about 10-11 months from cruise date. We will also be getting some Pre and Post Hotel packages in conjunction with the airline for further discounts. More information on that to follow in a few months.

We have until October of this year, 2015 to book our cabins before Viking and the travel agency will release any un-booked rooms to the general public for sale. We will also have a 30 day advance window for our group to book cabins on this boat before this happens. Your money is held in an Escrow account and will be given to Viking sometime around October. You will be notified before this happens. As the Longship books up, You will receive ALL available discounts and promotions, cash back vouchers, etc. that are available by the cruise line and travel agency. Other discounts and benefits will be divided among all those who place a reservation for the cruise.



### Miatas at Deer Valley, 2016

Our event Miatas at Deer Valley, is progressing well. We are currently reviewing a contract with our alternate resort hotel, The Lodges at Deer Valley, and getting ready to approve it once specific details are worked out. We are calling our event the "Miata Mountain Getaway" with "Life Elevated" as a Slogan which is a play on a Utah phrase most of us are familiar with. Our logo is very colorful and descriptive of the area venue where we are hosting our event.

Our event date is locked in. It will be held the next to last weekend in June, 2016. The official date now for **Miatas in Utah VII event is June 22-25, 2016** (Wednesday thru Saturday for four nights, checking out Sunday the 26th). There are many, many scenic drives around the Park City/Deer Valley area of Summit County. We have tons of great, spectacular drives planned. We also will be planning a Photo Shoot with our Miatas with a fabulous mountain backdrop and also our "Show & Shine" Car Show. Historic Park City is only ten minutes drive down the mountain with fabulous stores and boutiques for shopping and eating and many sites to see.

Our host resort hotel venue; The Chateaux, is located at the top of Deer Valley Mountain next to Stein Eriksen Lodge, a sister property. We will have access to 137 Rooms at The Chateaux. We also have another Deer Valley property, The Lodges of Deer Valley signed up for an additional 30 rooms per day. This is enough accommodations for 274 Miata attendees currently. If we need more rooms, there are other available hotel properties and condos we can get for additional rooms, if needed. The Lodges are located further down the Deer Valley mountain at the base of Snow Park, where the Amphitheater is that features summer outdoor concerts. The ambience of this resort property is the same as it is at The Chateaux. Both properties feature fine dining restaurants, a store, and other amenities.

Room Accommodations: Our hotel rooms will be different than our usual "hotel" type rooms that we have used in the past at our other Miata events. The rooms for accommodations will feature lodging options of Hotel Rooms, One-Bedroom Suites as well as two and three bedrooms suites which can be combined to allow more couples to "share" suites that come complete with full size gourmet kitchens and living rooms with big screen TV's and full bathrooms. They also have decks on each room for fantastic view of the mountains and resort area. This allows "groups" of Miata people from our club as well as other clubs to "share" rooms together with separate bedrooms per each couple with the addition of a "suite" as mentioned above for about \$100. more for a party of 4-6, which means that splitting the cost is less than \$150 per night for 4-Star accommodations. Soon we will have a link to their websites posted to book our rooms.

## Total Lunar Eclipse in September



Last April, on short notice, a small group of us gathered, in the wee early morning hours, at the South Town Mall to view a total lunar eclipse. It was the third of four Total Lunar Eclipses referred to as the 2014-2015 Tetrad (4 in a row).

The next and fourth Total Lunar Eclipse will be on the evening of Sunday September 27<sup>th</sup>, 2015 (Salt Lake Time). The eclipse will be underway at 7:13 PM when the moon rises over the Salt Lake valley. The moon will be in totality from 8:11 PM to 9:23 PM (max at 8:47 PM). After totality the Umbra (the major shadow of the earth) will travel across the moon till 10:27 PM, when the shows is pretty much over, but the Penumbra will actually end at 11:22 PM. This is ideal viewing time, no 3:00 AM alarm clock; it's the weather that's unpredictable.

We are very excited about this.





I would like to ask that all club members that are interested in a T-Shirt or Polo Shirt for these events please let me know and get on a list with your Name and shirt Size and we will make up one for you.

Susan Vaughn got with me to have a shirt designed for her Y.M.C.A. (Your Miata Canadian Adventure) event in July. The shirt design is in the making. We will have a T-Shirt printed on both sides with logo on front and Map on the back similar to what we did for the GWA and the GSWA. These shirts were very popular with everyone that went on these trips. We will also have a polo shirt made up also. If anyone wants a Long Sleeve-T or a Sweat Shirt, you can order one of those too. Just let Susan know when she passes the list around at the June Luncheon. I need your name and shirt size and if you want additional shirts (qty, style)

**Surf-N-Safari Shirts:** I have the permission of the SDMC (San Diego Miata Club) to use their logo on a custom shirt I plan to make for the UMC members to go to this event. It will be similar to what is described above for the YMCA shirts only with the S-N-S logo on it. We have a good contingency of club members going to this and I think the SDMC will be impressed with our version of their shirts. It reminds me of what the Bluebonnet Club from Texas did on creating their own version of shirt for our Moab event.



I am instituting a new way to sell and promote events with apparel. I am working with a company that will provide me with any type of apparel or promotional items from a coffee cup or water bottles to wall posters of your Miata with any of our current, past, present or future logos printed on them with no set-up costs, for the same cost that we have been paying for years. The best thing about this arrangement is that we can print one or 100 of the item. Instead of having to make items in bulk, with all the set up costs, we, or you, can order just one (1) item at a time. We will also be marketing this on our website and online and have our own "Café Press" type existence on our website. This will also make a small amount of money for the club. More will be explained on this later.



The club officers and directors has voted on the production of a special "ANNIVERSARY" Pin for the Utah Miata Club. This pin will have the official club logo on it. We want to make a pin which will honor all club members once they reach their "One Year", "Three Year", and "Five Year" anniversary of joining the club. The pin will be made of copper, silver, and gold metal for the 1, 3, & 5 year pins respectively. Each different pin will have the number designating the membership year.

We plan to actually give a member 3 pins once they have been with the club for five years. I know a lot of members are starting to collect Miata pins, so this will be nice to add to their personal collection.

We are also thinking about making a 10 year, 15 year, and 20 year anniversary pin next, to honor the long time members of the club. The pin will basically be the same and use the same die mold only not painted but be all copper, silver, or gold in the same format. They will be great collector's items for Utah Club Members. We think this is a good way to honor each member for their service in the club.

# Recipe Box

### Fresh Peach Bellinis

Makes 6 drinks

2 ripe peaches, seeded and sliced

1 Tbs fresh lemon juice

1 Tsp sugar

1 bottle chilled Prosecco sparkling wine

Place the peaches, lemon juice, sugar in food processor and process until smooth.

Press the mix through a sieve and discard the peach solids.

Place2 tbls of peach puree into each glass and fill with cold Champagne.

Serve immediately.



### Rainy Day Bean Soup

1 lb dried navy beans

7 cups water

1 ham bone

2 cups diced ham

1/4 cup minced onion

1/2 tsp salt

dash pepper

Rinse beans.

Heat beans and water to boiling; boil for 2 minutes.

Remove from heat; cover and let stand for 1 hour.

Add remaining ingredients.

Heat to boiling, cover and simmer for 2 hours or until beans are soft.

Add water if necessary.

Season to taste.
