

#### Summer BBQ Picnic Report by Mike Bailey



We now have half or 50% of the cabins for the Longship reserved! This is 50 Stateroom Cabins! The response has been overwhelming. All the French Balcony C and D cabins have been reserved. About half the cabins are with Utah Miata Club members and the other half are from members of 13 other Miata clubs in 14 different states. Some are family and friends of members that are not affiliated with a Miata club and don't want to miss this "trip of a lifetime."

New News this month is that Morris Murdock Travel has cartered the entire Longship. Viking will be able to cater to our group exclusively. Yes, we will own the ship, so to speak. We passed out over 60 DVD's at the ZTMOET event and Donn passed our more this past weekend at MOT in Boston which had 150 Miatas attending. We expect to get some new bookings from this. We welcome everyone who wants to come. This 15 day European River Tour will be the second week of July 2017, so we are exactly 2 years away from our departure time. Brent Jenson of Morris Murdock Travel is working on getting us some specific dates for the trip.

This cruise is specially priced at 2 FOR 1 Rates. It is a 2017 cruise for 2015 Pricing. The Deposit of \$500. per person is half the normal deposit required. If you are interested contact us and we will give you a FREE DVD of the cruise and email you links so you can view the ship, cabins, and itinerary. We have a Reservation Form that you can fill out with all the information that the travel agency needs to book your cabin. We will also email you a Deck Plan which lists all the rooms which are color coded and have pricing for each room. Hurry and get your Rooms booked NOW, as they are going fast and almost half of the Longship is already booked.

We are working with Morris Murdock Travel in Salt Lake and you can speak to our Cruise Agent, Amber Lee Johanson to book the cruise. Her phone number is 801-483-6314. Or you can email her at ajohanson@morrismurdock.com. The deposit is only \$500.00 per person (double occupancy/ 2 people per room). Note: Cabin Stateroom prices listed are per person. Deposit is fully refundable (see details on this). Just pay your deposit and set some money aside each month towards payment of the cruise. We recommend Travel Insurance which will be available several months from now (around October 2015) to protect your investment in case something comes up.

The word out now to other Miata people across the country in other Miata Clubs to join us and is also on the Miata. Net Forum for the Southwest Region. You can get all the information and Registration form, Deck Plan and Itinerary on the Net, so sign up while the best rooms are still available. Information on Flights and cost of that part will be available about 10-11 months prior to the cruise date. We will also be getting some Pre and Post Hotel packages in conjunction with the airline for further discounts. More information on that to follow in a few months.

We have until October of this year, 2015 to book our cabins before Viking and the travel agency will release any un-booked rooms to the general public for sale. We will also have a 30 day advance window for our group to book cabins on this boat before this happens. Your money is held in an Escrow account and will be given to Viking sometime around October. You will be notified before this happens. As the Longship books

Great News! We are ready to start the Registration process for Miatas in Deer Valley. The Registration form is attached or you can go to our new website and click on the Miatas in Utah page and download it, print it out, FILL out your Registration Form today, and mail it in with a check for the fee. The Registration this year is \$125.00 per person. Register before December 31, 2015 as the Registration Fee goes up to \$145.00 on January 1, 2016. We need to pay a substantial deposit for the facilities on January 9th of which funds for this will come from the registrations.

The Registration fee includes the cost of the food for the Welcome Social on Thursday night and also the Gourmet Banquet Dinner for our Saturday night program and Closing Ceremonies. This will feature a fabulous dinner prepared by award winning chefs at The Chateaux. It is an \$80 dinner value per person so you won't want to miss it and you will get your money's worth. Event fee also includes an Event Pin, Goodie Bag full of surprises, Ticket for Give-Away Drawings. all the printed handouts, etc.

The date is set - the evening of **Sunday September 27<sup>th</sup>**, **2015** (Salt Lake Time). The eclipse will be **underway at 7:13 PM when the moon rises** over the Salt Lake valley. The moon will be in **totality from 8:11 PM to 9:23 PM** (max at 8:47 PM). After totality the Umbra (the major shadow of the earth) will travel across the moon till 10:27 PM, when the shows is pretty much over.

Let's hold our own Eclipse Party at **Soldier Hollow Golf Course** (1370 Soldier Hollow Dr., Midway, Ut 84049). Jim and Margie have arranged to use the parking lot, off the wet grass, near the Club House if we need warmth, etc. Between now and the Club luncheon on September 5<sup>th</sup>, we can pick a place to meet for dinner. Then travel to Soldier Hollow before sunset.

Plan on bringing: Warm clothing/Blankets! Hot drinks, Bug Repellent, Lawn chair, Binoculars/ Telescope, etc. Our only variable is the weather - hoping for clear skies.

For those not able to attend, the eclipse can be seen any where the moon can be seen during the eclipse. Your location is not critical like a solar eclipse.


#### New 4th Generation Miata Revealed! By Mike Bailey

#### **Caramel Pecan Sundaes**

1 1/2 cups sugar

1 1/4 cups heavy cream

1/2 teaspoon pure vanilla extract

2 pints vanilla ice cream

2 pints butter pecan ice cream

Toasted pecans

For caramel; mix 1/3 cup water and the sugar in a medium size heavy pan.

Cook without stirring, over low heat for 5 to 10 minutes until the sugar dissolves.

Increase the heat to med and boil uncovered until the sugar turns chestnut brown about 350 degrees on a candy thermometer about 5 to 7 minutes. Be careful.

Turn the heat off.

Slowly add the vanilla.

The cream will bubble violently and the caramel will solidify.



#### **Old Fashioned Carrot Salad**

1/2 cup golden raisins

2 pounds carrots

3 tablespoons sugar

3 tablespoons fresh lemon juice

1/4 cup sour cream

1/2 cup good mayonaise

1 tablespoons kosher salt

1 1/2 teaspoons black pepper

1 cup diced golden pineapple

Place raisins in a small bowl and add enough hot tap water to cover ,set aside

Fit a food processor with the coarsest grating disk.

Wash carrots and grate place then in a large bowl

Add the rest of all the ingredients.

Set for few hours.

You can also add nuts to this salad.
