- The name 'MX-5' was contrived from 'Mazda Experiment' and being project number 5.
- In the Disney/Pixar film Cars, characters 'Mia' and 'Tia' are both based off of the MX-5. If you look hard enough, both of their names resemble 'Miata'!


November Luncheon Report By: Valerie Francis

Member Spotlight By: Carol Lynn Vredeveld


Our spotlight couple this month is Tom and Pam Wharram

She started looking for one at our dealer sponsor, Bountiful Mazda. She drove a brand new RF and also a used 2016 there. She loved the new one but decided it was too expensive, and really didn't like the 2016 she drove, nor the color of it. She also could not decide on buying an automatic or a manual transmission. I told her to drive both, which she did.

She checked out KSL.com and they didn't have many available from private parties. There was a pristine 1999 10th Anniversary Edition for sale in Ogden but it had lots of miles on it, and RoseAnn was wary of a car with lots of miles. The other KSL ads were from dealers. She looked at several and finally decided on a Reflex Blue 2017 GT with fairly low miles and fell in love with it. It had all the "bells and whistles" on it so this is what she got. I'm happy for her and welcome, RoseAnn, to our "Miata Family".





Most Reliable New Car \$ Can Buy By: Mike Bailey



"The Most Reliable New Car You Can Buy Starts at \$25,000". This is the headline on an article by Michael Tedder that was published November 18, 2019 by Consumer Reports. They recently unveiled itheir 'Annual Auto Survey' which studies data collected on over 420,000 vehicles to determine which cars will, overall give their owners the least amount of headaches. The survey looked at 17 common complaints such as squeaky brakes and broken interior trim, to major complaints like 'out-of-warranty' transmission repairs or trouble with four-wheel drive systems, and other common factors and issues, to come up with a "Predicted Reliability Score". Consumer Reports states that the score is then compared to da-

ta collected from the their own track testing, as well as owner satisfaction survey results and safety data to calculate each test vehicle's "Overall Score".

When all the data was put together they came up with a "Top 10" from the thousands of cars that were surveyed. Those cars that made the top ten is considered an amazing feat because of all the items, both good and bad, that the intensive survey included in it's report. Cars were rated on a scale of "1 to 100" points.

The 2020 MX-5 Miata was rated #1 pick as the top car of any entry! This is an incredible honor for the auto industry, and Mazda. The Miata had a total score of 95. The Chevrolet Colorado had the worst reliability rating with a score of 4 out of 100 points (sorry Chevy!). What is particularly interesting is that "reliability" and "price" are not necessarily closely tied together. In other words, 'a more expensive car does not automatically translate into one without hassles' the report says. Sometimes low-priced cars rate very high in terms of reliability. Five of the top 10 most reliable new cars start under \$30,000.

It is also surprising to note that Mazda has 3 models in the Top 10 from this survey. Miata ranked #1, Score 95, Starting price at \$25,730. Toyota Prius Prime and Toyota Prius Standard was ranked #2 and #3 respectively with scores of 94 and 92, but priced \$2,000 more on the Prime than the Miata. The Lexus GX ranked #4 with Score of 91 but costs \$53,000, more than twice the cost of a Miata. Mazda's CX-3 ranked #5, Score of 89 at \$20,390. #6 was Hyundai Kona, Score 90, \$20,100. #7 was Mazda CX-9, Score 87, \$33,790. Rounding out Ranking 8-10 was the Lexus NX, Toyota 4Runner, and Lexus GS, all considerably more than a Miata or another Mazda.

To sum it up, Mazda puts out an excellent vehicle in the Miata, as all our club members know. In addition to excellence and reliability look how much fun we have in our Miatas. As Mazda has said in their corporate advertising for the First Generation NA MX-5: "Miata is Always the Answer". This is indeed a correct statement and it has carried this slogan for 30 years! I even have this on my Christmas Sweater for this year!
